

ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2025-2026

Seshadripuram Law College was established in the academic year 1984–85 under the aegis of the Seshadripuram Educational Trust. The institution stands as a testament to the Trust’s mission of nurturing students to become intellectually vibrant, morally upright, and socially responsible citizens, equipped with a positive outlook and committed to continuous personal and professional growth. For the academic year 2025–2026, the college admitted 61 students to the first year of the five-year B.A., LL.B. program and 121 students to the first year of the three-year LL.B. program. The academic session formally commenced on 13 August 2025.

6.
